ORDER

Punjab State Power Corporation Limited (PSPCL) filed the present Petition seeking adjudication of disputes under the Power Purchase Agreement dated 18.01.2010 executed with Nabha Power Limited (NPL) regarding computation of the energy charges claimed by NPL.

NPL opposed the admission of the Petition submitting that the contentions raised by PSPCL in the present petition are identical to the contentions already raised and decided by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and hence the petition is not maintainable. After hearing the parties, the Commission, vide order dated 06.04.2022, held that the Petition is maintainable and admitted the Petition. NPL challenged the Order dated 06.04.2022 passed by the Commission before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No. 2425 1.0-6

of 2023 with Civil Appeal No. 2426 of 2023 vide Order dated 09.10.2023 has set aside the impugned order and allowed the Appeals. The present petition is accordingly disposed of in view of the order dated 09.10.2023 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
