ORDER

Some residents of Gulmohar Residency presented themselves before the Commission and pleaded for release of permanent electricity connections. While giving patient hearing to the residents, the Commission advised them to get themselves impleaded as respondents by submitting applications to that effect.

Regarding release of temporary connections to the individual residents of the colony for which NOC has not been issued by PSPCL, the officer representing PSPCL submitted that there were no specific instructions of release of temporary connections to such residents but now PSPCL has issued specific

instructions dated 07.08.2020 to regulate release of temporary connections in the colonies which are being followed by the field officers.

Sh. R.S.Dhiman, counsel for the petitioners, made himself available online only after the hearing ended and was accordingly asked to appear on the next date of hearing in person as the internet connection at his end is probably not working properly. Representatives of the Developer and GMADA did not appear. The Commission directs that notices be issued to GMADA through Secretary, Department of Housing & Urban Development, Govt. of Punjab.
