ORDER

- a) Date wise details of loan received from various lenders (supported by relevant bank statements);
- b) Date wise details of capital expenditure / investments made corresponding to loan received (supported by relevant bank statements);
- c) Loan agreements entered with all lenders; and
- d) Documentary evidence to verify the interest rate fluctuations.

PSPCL shall file reply to the amended petition within three weeks with a copy to the petitioner (through email and hard copy) and rejoinder, if any, be filed by the petitioner within next two weeks (through email and hard copy).

The petition shall be taken up for hearing / arguments on 25.04.2018 at 11.00 A.M.
