ORDER

The petition was taken up for hearing. Vide Order dated 24.11.2022, the Principal Secretary, Local Govt. and Principal Secretary Housing and Urban Development as well as the respondents were directed to file reply to the proposal submitted by PSPCL within two weeks. Special Secretary, Govt. of Punjab Housing and Urban Development, Chandigarh has filed its reply dated 05.12.2022. However, respondent No. 01 neither appeared nor filed its reply. Respondent No. 2, 3 & 4 have also not filed reply to the proposal submitted by PSPCL and the Ld. Counsel for the respondents No. 2,3 & 4 requested for time to file reply. The respondents are granted the last opportunity to file their respective reply to the proposal submitted by PSPCL within two weeks.

PSPCL has filed IA No. 29 of 2022 submitting that a meeting of the high powered inter-departmental committee was convened on 30.09.2022 wherein it has been proposed for extension in validity of expired NOCs including OTS for old NOC cases and allowing temporary connection upto 10 KW for sales offices without precondition of NOC. PSPCL has submitted minutes of meeting in support of the IA and has prayed for allowing the IA. On a query by the Commission as to whether any instructions/notification have been issued by the Govt. in this regard, it was submitted by PSPCL that no notification has been issued by the Govt. The IA cannot be considered merely on the basis of the minutes of a meeting. PSPCL may take up the matter with the Govt. to take specific policy decision

and issue required notifications on issues discussed in the meeting on the basis of whose comments, IA has been filed. Only after a specific policy is notified by the Govt, should PSPCL file a petition seeking the Commission's approval on specific points duly considered and proposed by PSPCL for approval by the Commission.

Moreover, PSPCL was asked to explain whether the proposals contained in the IA would not require amendment in the Supply Code Regulations. PSPCL was asked to justify the maintainability of the I.A.

The I.A alongwith the petition shall be taken up for hearing on 26.04.2023 at 11.30 AM.
