Petition under section 86 of Electricity Act, 2003 for setting aside the letter / order dated 30.01.2023 passed by the Respondent No. 2 i.e. Chief Engineer (Power Purchase and Regulation), PSPCL, whereby unjust and arbitrary recovery amounting to Rs. 3,02,82,726/- (i.e. Rs. 1,80,14,020/- as principal amount + Rs. 1,22,68,706/- as interest) is imposed on petitioner i.e. Generating company in complete and utter violation of prevalent laws Rules and regulations set forth by PSPCL itself.
