ORDER

The petition was taken up for hearing as well as public hearing. Sh. Harkesh Singh from Patiala, has appeared in the public hearing and submitted his suggestions. The copy of the same has been provided to PSPCL. PSPCL shall reply to the suggestions within three days (through hard copy & soft copy).

PSPCL has sought amendment in the settlement period specified in PSERC (Grid Interactive Rooftop Solar Voltaic Systems) Regulations, 2023 for cotton ginning, pressing and baling plants, rice shellers and rice bran stabilization units (without T.G. Sets). As per condition 18.2 of the General Conditions of Tariff, 6 industries have been approved as seasonal industries. However, PSPCL has proposed amendment for three seasonal industries.

PSPCL shall explain the reasons for not including the other seasonal industries for the applicability of proposed settlement period. PSPCL is also directed to explain how energy accounting and settlement in respect of seasonal industrial consumers for the current settlement period shall be governed. Also in respect of the existing Rooftop SPV systems already commissioned under the existing regulations shall be governed after the amendment in the settlement period as proposed by the PSPCL. PSPCL shall submit its reply within two weeks.

The petition shall be taken up for hearing on 06.03.2024 at 11.30 AM.
