Petition for addition of the work of construction of stone/boulder masonry, parapet wall on cement concrete lining, from RD 33310M to 35500M on both banks of Mukerian Hydel Channel Stage-1 for which Agenda No. 380 dated 23.02.2021 has been approved by BODS in its 86th meeting held at Mohali on 26.02.2021 for CAPEX Plan 2021-22.

ORDER

The Commission has examined the submissions of the petitioner. The Commission observes that Capital Investment Plan in respect of PSPCL for 2nd MYT (FY 2020-21 to FY 2022-23) was approved vide Order dated 03.12.2019 in Petition No. 18 of 2019.

PSPCL has filed the present petition submitting that there is requirement of addition of the new scheme of urgent nature for construction of stone/boulder masonry, parapet wall on cement concrete lining, from RD 33310M to 35500M on both banks of Mukerian Hydel Channel Stage-1. The Board of Directors of PSPCL vide its decision taken in the meeting held on dated 26.02.2021 decided as under:

“ Resolved that administrative approval be and is hereby accorded for carrying out constructions of Stone/Boulder Masonry, Parapat wall as per proposal in Para 2 from RD 33310m to 35500m on both banks of MHC-I at an estimated cost of Rs. 132 Lac (including establishment cost and Interest capitalization charges).

Further resolved that budget amounting of Rs. 132 Lac under Capital account head, including establishment charges and interest capitalization be and is hereby allocated for the financial year 2021-22”

As per Regulation 9.14 of the MYT Regulations 2019, PSPCL may take up the work prior to the approval of the Commission provided that the scheme has been approved by its Board of Directors as being of emergent nature. Therefore, PSPCL may take up the work as mentioned in the petition.

Regarding new schemes to be considered for approval, PSPCL is directed to consolidate all such schemes and file a single composite petition instead of filing petition for each scheme separately.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of accordingly.
