**PUBLIC NOTICE**

The Punjab State Power Corporation Limited (PSPCL) vide Petition No. 60 of 2011 has sought an amendment in Clause 25 of the Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Intra State Open Access) Regulations, 2011 as under:

Clause as per Open Access Regulations	Amendment proposed by PSPCL in Open Access Regulations
<b><i>Sub-section (5) of Clause 25</i></b> <i>Long term, Medium term and Short term Open Access customers availing supply at 33/66 KV, in addition to transmission charges, shall be liable to pay 15% of the wheeling charges determined by the Commission as per the Tariff Order applicable for the year; whereas customers availing supply at 11 KV shall be liable to bear 30% of wheeling charges in addition to transmission charges.</i>	<b><i>Sub-section (5) of Clause 25</i></b> <i>Long term, Medium term and Short term Open Access customers availing supply at 220 KV, 132 KV, 33/66 KV or 11 KV, in addition to transmission charges, shall be liable to pay 100% of the wheeling charges determined by the Commission as per the Tariff Order applicable for the year.</i>
