Petition under Regulation 47 of Supply Code-2014 (amended upto date) and Regulation 69,70,71 & 72 of Chapter XIII of the Conduct of Business Regulations 2005 for relaxation of Regulation 6.5 of Supply code 2014 by Punjab State Power Corporation Limited for seeking relaxation of Supply code from Hon'ble Commission to allow one connection in multiple premises, If an applicant applies for single new connection at different locations or an existing unit undertake expansion at different location and if it has same GST number, the locations are separated by a canal/ Road or are adjoining each other and manufacturing process at both the locations is interlinked for connection of 25 MW/25 MVA at 66 kV supply voltage and new connection of M/s Oasis Enterprises.

ORDER

The Petition was taken up for hearing on admission. The petitioner i.e. PSPCL has submitted that M/s. Oasis Enterprises has a running LS connection at 66 kV supply with sanctioned load/contract demand of 25 MW/25 MVA. Further, the firm requires a connection to another plot having same GST number, same Board of Directors and interlinked manufacturing process, which is separated from the existing plot by a road. The petitioner has further drawn reference to the Punjab Industrial and Business Development Policy, 2022, i.e. if an existing unit undertakes expansion at different location then it shall be treated as expansion case if it has same GST number, the locations are separated by a canal/road or are adjoining each other and manufacturing process at both the locations is interlinked. The petitioner has then prayed for relaxation in Regulation 6.5 of the Supply Code, 2014 to allow single connection to M/s. Oasis Enterprises in multiple premises as a special case.

During the hearing, the officer representing PSPCL stated that a proposal on the same issue has already been submitted separately to the Commission for amendment in the Supply Code. Since, the matter will be deliberated upon by the Supply Code Review Panel and the decision regarding amendment in the Supply Code, 2014 shall be taken thereafter, so present petition is not maintainable at this stage and is disposed of accordingly.
