## **ORDER**

The petition was taken up for hearing. Vide order dated 11.07.2024, PSPCL was directed to file its reply to explain the repeated extensions in the timeline for releasing connection which could not be foreseen at the time of filing the petition. PSPCL has filed its reply only on 20.08.2024, vide memo no. 6297 dated 20.08.2024. Northern Railway has filed its reply dated 20.08.2024 to the rejoinder dated 08.07.2024 filed by PSPCL which is taken on record. Northern Railway may further submit its comments/reply within one week to the reply submitted by PSPCL vide memo no. 6297 dated 20.08.2024 with a copy to PSPCL.

The Ld. Counsel appearing for PSPCL requested that as the work was being done through PSTCL, so PSTCL be also impleaded as a necessary party. The Commission however, observes that the electricity

connection is to be released by PSPCL for which the demand notice has been issued by PSPCL. Only the amount received in this regard from Northern Railway was transferred by PSPCL to PSTCL to get the work done through the latter. Thus, the request for impleading PSTCL as a party in the petition is not tenable. PSPCL shall submit a detailed affidavit within two weeks, giving the timeline for releasing the connection.

The Petition shall be taken up for hearing on 16.10.2024 at 11.30 AM.
