## **ORDER**

The petition was taken up for hearing. During hearing on 06.11.2024, the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner sought time to file its rejoinder and the petitioner was granted last opportunity to file the same within one week. The petitioner has not filed its rejoinder. Counsel of the Petitioner, the Commission observed that the petition has become infructuous qua the petitioner thus the petition is disposed of accordingly.

After considering the averments made in the petition, the Commission noted that the petition also involves the issue of general nature regarding the delay in the implementation of the orders passed by the
