Petition under Section 86 (1) (a) of the Electricity Act, 2003 and/or any other enabling provision applicable in law to:-

- A. Re-determine the tariff of the 23 MW Non-Fossil Fuel based Co-Generation Power Plant (Bagasse Based), operated by the Petitioner in furtherance of the Power Purchase Agreement dated 10.09.2012 executed between M/s Chadha Sugars and Industries Pvt. Ltd. Petitioner herein and the Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. Patiala.
- B. Re-determine the tariff of the 23 MW Non-Fossil Fuel based Co-generation Power Plant (Bagasse Based), operated by the Petitioner by applying the parameters set-out by the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (CERC) vide order dated 12.08.2022.
- C. Restrain the Respondents from terminating, breaching or altering the terms of the Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) dated 10.09.2012 executed between the Petitioner and the Second Respondent during the pendency of the present Petition and/or restrain the Respondents from initiating any coercive/punitive measures against the Petitioner during the pendency of the present petition.

## ORDER
