**ORDER**

The Commission asked PSPCL as to whether loading conditions of the feeders and the feasibility of releasing connections in the cases where feasibility clearance was given more than two years ago would have remained unchanged till date. The officer of PSPCL submitted that loading conditions could have changed in some cases which might necessitate review of feasibility clearance. The Commission further observed that charging demand notice extension fee for every intervening quarter might not be in line with the spirit of the proposal which envisaged giving relief to consumers. The officer of the PSPCL prayed for the permission of the Commission to revise the petition. Permission is granted to PSPCL to submit revised petition within a week.
