Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent has submitted that the Order dated 15.09.2019 has been challenged before the Hon'ble APTEL vide appeal No. 18 of 2021 on the ground that PSPCL cannot be forced to enter into a PPA at a higher tariff than what was originally envisaged and requested to defer the hearing till the time the appeal before the Hon'ble APTEL is finally decided.

Having regard to the circumstances, the hearing in the present petition is deferred for awaiting final decision of the appeal by the Hon'ble APTEL.
