**ORDER**

The Review Petition was taken up for hearing. The information sought by the Commission vide order dated 17.05.2024 has been submitted by PSPCL vide memo no. 4327 dated 28.06.2024. During hearing, the Ld. counsel for Review Petitioner contended that while calculating the voltage wise cost of supply PSPCL has taken transmission losses for 400 kV line as 2.4% whereas as per Regulation 12 of the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Rates, Charges and Terms and Conditions for use of Intervening Transmission Facilities) Regulations, 2010 the transmission losses for the 400 kV line length of every 50 Km used should be 0.5%. The Ld. Counsel for the Review Petitioner requested for time to submit its written submission in this regard. The same may be filed within two weeks with a copy to PSPCL (through hard & soft copy). PSPCL may

file its reply thereto within three weeks thereafter with a copy to the Review Petitioner (through hard & soft copy).

The Review Petition shall be taken up for hearing on 21.08.2024 at 11.30 AM.
