ORDER

The review petition was taken up for hearing on admission. The petitioner filed petition No. 53 of 2021 for direction to PSPCL to allow/grant banking facility for its CPP being operated with renewable biomass fuel, as per the provisions of PSERC (Harnessing of Captive Power Generation) Regulation 2009 read with NRSE Policy 2012, which was dismissed vide Order dated 04.05.2022. During the pendency of the present Review Petition, the Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Harnessing of Captive Power Generation) Regulations 2022, have been notified vide notification No. PSERC/Secy./Regu./166 dated 27.10.2022. Regulation 12 of the above Regulations provides as under:

"12. Repeal and savings"

- (i) The Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Harnessing of Captive Power Generation) Regulations, 2009 along with amendments shall stand repealed from the date of commencement of these Regulations.
- (ii) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or purported to have been done under the repealed Regulations shall deemed to have been done or purported to have been done under these Regulations.
- (iii) On the commencement of these Regulations, any reference to "Captive Power Plant (CPP) in any other Regulations or Order of the Commission shall deemed to be replaced with "Captive Generating Plant (CGP)".

As Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Harnessing of Captive Power Generation) Regulations 2022 have been notified vide notification PSERC/Secy./Regu./166 dated 27.10.2022, repealing the CPP Regulations 2009, the present review petition is disposed of accordingly.
