ORDER

The petition was taken up for hearing on admission. PSPCL has filed the present petition that case of M/s Malwa Industries Limited and M/s Malwa Garments Units may be allowed to be considered under OTS scheme pending the LPA and CWP filed by the consumer before the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh. PSPCL filed Petition No. 05 of 2023 for introduction of One Time Settlement Scheme for all categories of defaulting consumers (except AP) which was disposed of by the Commission vide order dated 15.05.2023. It has been clearly mandated in Para No. 10 (v) of the order that the cases pending before the courts which have not yet been finalized would have to be withdrawn before the defaulters are considered under the OTS Scheme and then arrears can be settled under the OTS Scheme. The cases of all the consumers are required to be considered under the OTS scheme already approved by the Commission in its order dated 15.05.2023 in Petition No. 05 of 2023 and individual cases should not be brought before the Commission for special consideration beyond the approved scheme. The petition filed by PSPCL does not merit to be admitted and is dismissed in liminie.
