No. PSERC/ Secy/ Regu.174.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(6) of Section 42 of the Electricity Act,2003 read with Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Forum and Ombudsman) Regulations, 2016 amended from time to time, the Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission is pleased to appoint Ms. Anjuli Chandra as Ombudsman, Electricity, Punjab w.e.f. 01.07.2023 on the following terms and conditions:-

- 1. The appointment shall be for a period of three years from the date of her taking the charge which may be extended by the Commission upto a maximum period of five years subject to age limit of 70 years.
- 2. She will be paid a fixed remuneration of Rs. 1,15,000/- (One lac fifteen thousand per month and Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) per month towards Transport Allowance as prescribed by the Commission.
- 3. She shall be entitled to 20 days Casual Leave per annum and Extraordinary Leave upto 03 months during the entire tenure/period of service.
- 4. Her office shall be located at 66 KV Grid Sub-Station, Plot no. A-2, Industrial Area, Phase-I, S.A.S Nagar (Mohali).
- 5. She may relinquish her office by giving a notice of not less than 03 months in writing to the Commission.
- 6. TA/DA shall be admissible as admissible to Grade-1 officers of the Government of Punjab.
- 7. Before assuming charge, she will subscribe to the oath of office and secrecy before Chairperson, PSERC.
- 8. The other terms and conditions of his appointment shall be as specified in the Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Forum and Ombudsman) Regulations, 2016 as amended from time to time.
