VACANCY CIRCULAR

Applications are invited for filling up of a post of Joint Director/M&F, in the pay scale of Rs.41300-67000 + 9600 GP from serving /retired officers of Central/State Government or PSU under Central/State Government having following educational & other qualifications:

(a) Minimum Educational Qualification:

CA/ICWA/CFA/CPA or MBA in Finance

(b) Qualifying service:

- (i) Serving/Retired Officers of the Central/State Government or PSU under State/Central Government must have experience of working on the post in the scale of Rs.37400-67000+8700 GP or Minimum 6 years experience of working on the post in the scale of Rs.15600-39100 +Rs.7600 GP equivalent post

Or

- (ii) Minimum fifteen years experience of working in power sector out of which three years experience in a senior assignment relating to Electricity Laws, Commercial/Regulatory affairs, Financial management and other activities relevant to the working of the Commission.

(c) Nature of Experience:

- (i) Tariff formulation or cost analysis or financial management
(ii) Working knowledge of Computer.
(iii) Matric pass in Punjabi language.

(d) Pay and Allowances:

- (i) The pay scale and allowances of the employees will be equivalent to those prevalent in PSPCL/PSTCL .In the case of deputationists , they shall continue to draw the pay scale of their parent departments plus deputation allowance. The employees on deputation will be entitled to draw all admissible allowances at such rates and subject to such conditions as may be applicable to the employees of the parent

department or as mutually agreed between the Commission and the parent department.

(ii) The re-employed pensioners will get the last pay drawn less pension plus other allowances as applicable.

(iii) Those appointed on contract will be entitled to draw pay and allowances or fixed remuneration as decided by the Commission.

2. Appointment shall be initially for a period of one year which would be extendable. The applicant should not be above 60 years of age as on 1.3.2013.

3. Applications should be submitted within 15 days from the date of publication of this advertisement to the undersigned. Applicant serving in a utility should submit their applications through proper channel with an advance copy to the Commission within specified period.
